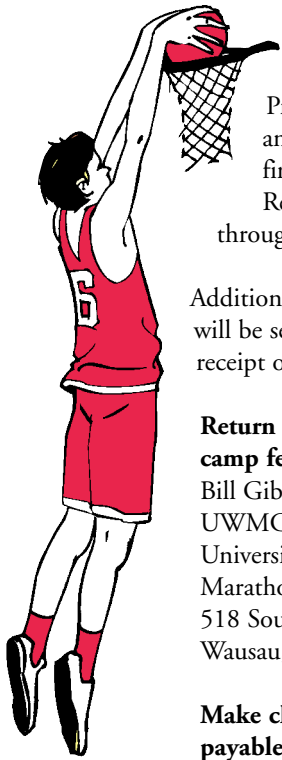


REGISTRATION
